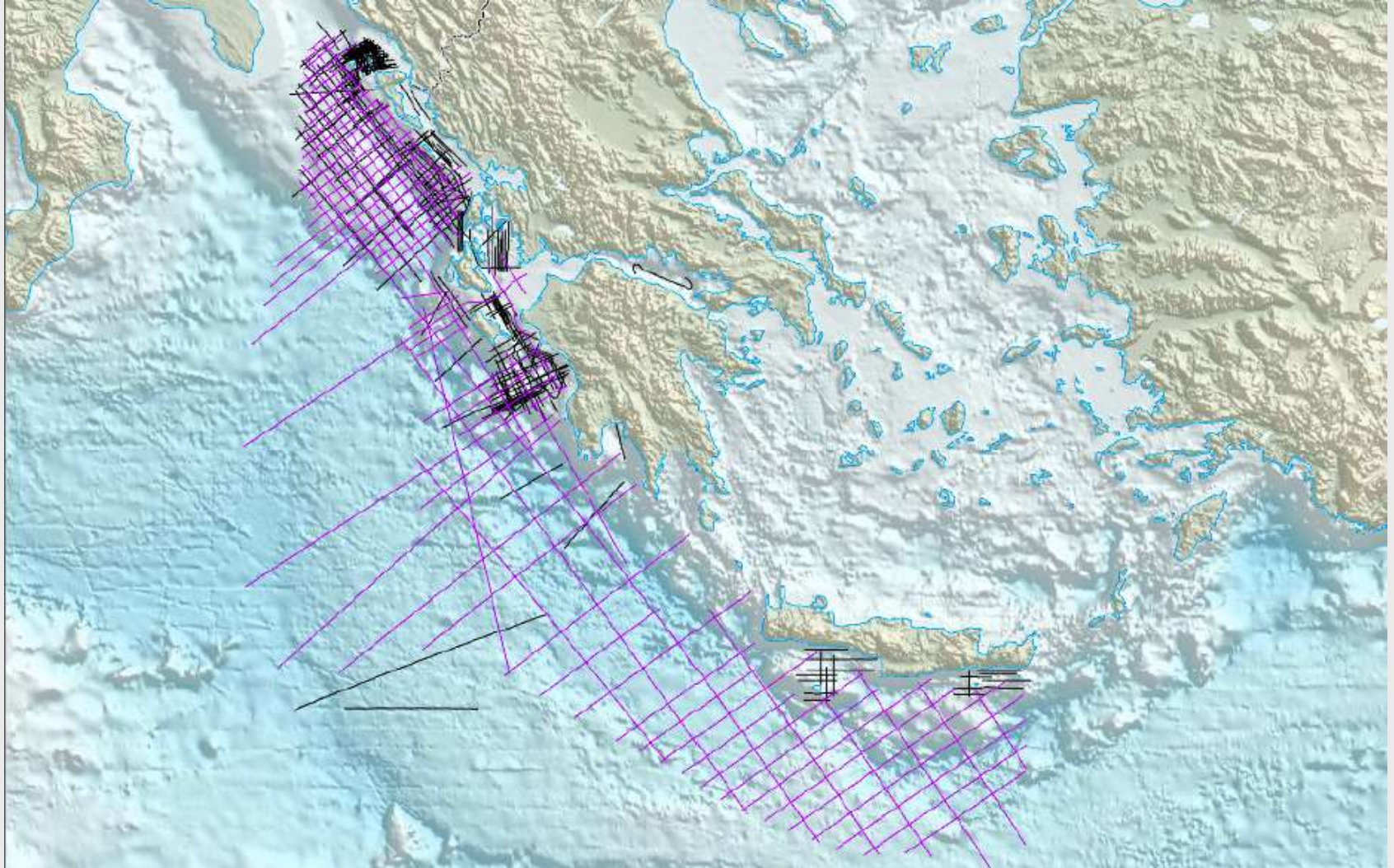


Significant energy projects classified by the European Commission as “Projects of Common Interest” are “Greece related”

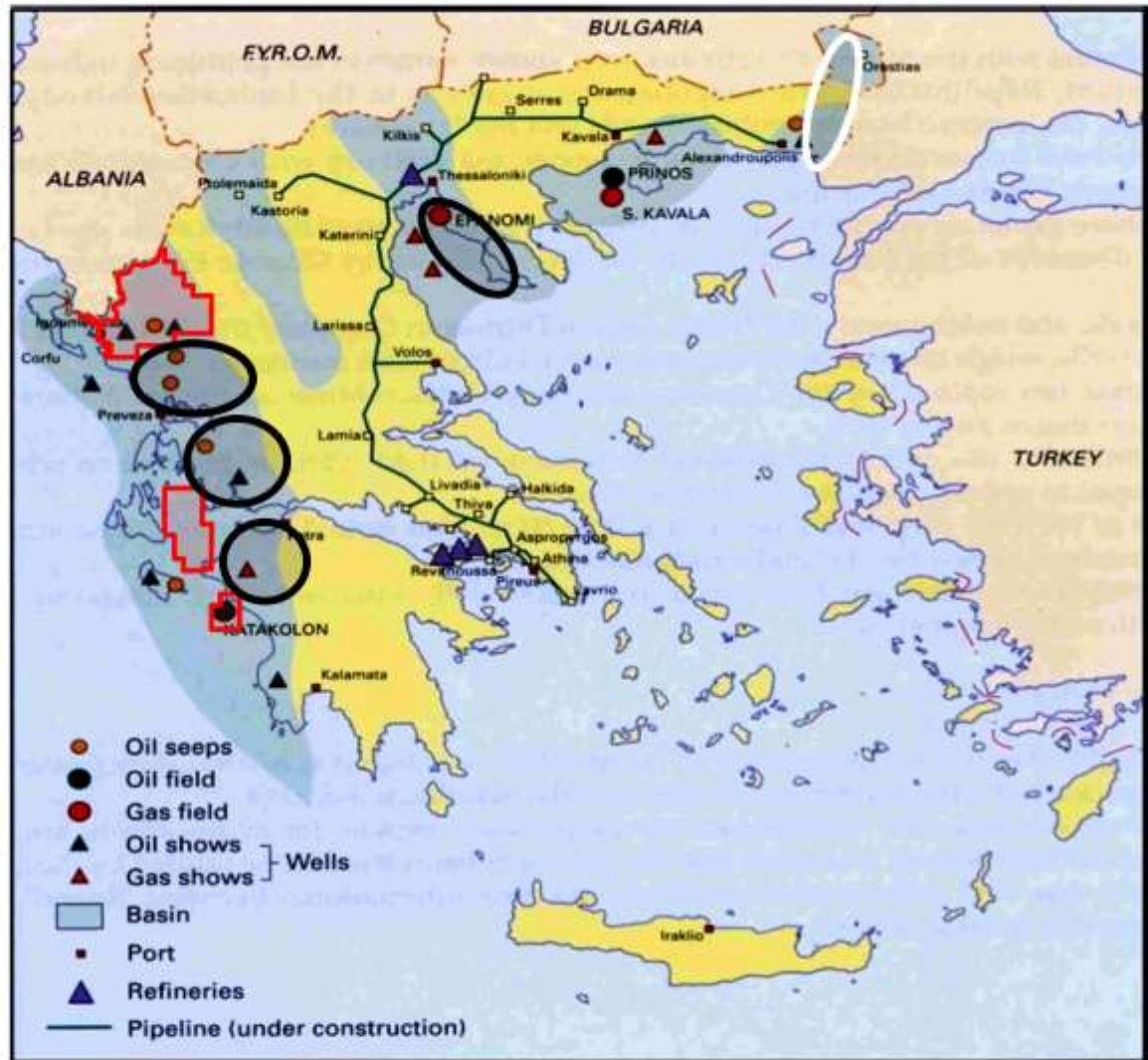
